GENERAL INFORMATION

- Entry Fees:** Pre-Entries \$18.00 - Post-Entries \$20.00/class. Entries close Thursday prior to the horse show. No entries taken after 9:00 P.M. in the evening.
- Neither the Horse Show Committee** nor Brass Ring/Three Ring Circus Horse Show will be responsible for any damage, injury or loss to persons, horse/pony or property of exhibitor or spectator incurred on or off the horse show grounds.
- The Horse Show Management** reserves the right to combine, divide, cancel or change the order of classes when necessary.
- Anyone or any horse/pony** suspended from the USEF will not be permitted to show at this CCHSA Horse Show.
- Classes for Juniors** will be limited to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to December 1st of the previous year.
- Hard Hats** must be worn in classes, during schooling and while mounted. All riders must wear harnesses.
- Six Ribbons** will be awarded in all classes unless otherwise specified. Championship and Reserve Championship ribbons will be awarded in each division.
- No Martingales** will be permitted in under saddle classes, unless otherwise stated in the class specs.
- The decision of the Judge** and/or horse show officials will be final.
- Schooling** will be permitted until 10 minutes before the start of the show.
- All fence heights** are approximate.
- ALL DOGS MUST BE KEPT LEASHED – RADNOR PONY CLUB RULE.**
- Additions and Scratches** must be made with the Secretary before the class begins. Any horses showing and not entered will be charged a fee of \$10 per class, per horse in addition to the entry fee. Horses wishing to scratch must do so before the class enters the ring or they will be charged for that class.
- A blank check or payment** must be received before numbers are released. A fee of \$35 will be charged for all returned checks.
